BY-LAWS

ARTICLE I * NAME

The name of this Detachment shall be, the W. H. Nichols Detachment, #940, Marine Corps League.
These bylaws are to be consistent with the bylaws and administrative procedures issued by the Department and the National organization.

ARTICLE II * PURPOSE

The purposes for which this Detachment is formed are to: (National Bylaws Chapter One, Section 100)

- A. Preserve the traditions and to promote the interests of the United States Marine Corps.
- B. Band together those who are now serving in the United States Marine Corps and those who have been honorably discharged or retired from that service in fellowship that they may effectively promote the ideals of American freedom and democracy.
- C. Fit its members for duties of citizenship and to encourage them to serve as ably as citizens as they have served the Nation under arms.
- D. Hold sacred the history and memory of the men who have given their lives to this Nation, to foster love and respect for the principles which they have supported by blood and valor since the founding of the Republic..
- E. Maintain true allegiance to American institutions.
- F. Create a bond of comradeship between those in the service and those who have returned to civilian life.
- G. Aid voluntarily and to render assistance to all Marines and FMF Corpsmen, Navy Chaplains, and former Marines and FMF Corpsmen as well as to their spouses, orphans, and parents.
